STAGE 1 – CONCRETE PRACTICE is an industry-recognised entry-level qualification in practical concreting awarded by The Institute of Concrete Technology. It is a formal certificate in recognition of mastering the basic objectives of activities in the concrete industry.

This one day seminar outlines the aims, objectives and content of the ICT syllabus with discussions on key topics and culminating in a practice exam. Designed for those with experience of working in the concrete industry such as; technicians, operatives, batch plant supervisors, sales and distribution staff and concrete mixer operators/drivers, to achieve a formal certificate in recognition of their success in mastering the basic objectives of activities in the concrete industry. Key topics include: concrete constituents, producing, transporting, handling and placing, concrete construction applications, sampling, testing and inspection. COVID-19 - Strathclyde University Technology and Innovation Centre

The Strathclyde University Technology and Innovation Centre will follow all necessary precautions relating to the COVID-19 issues prevailing at the time of the course. Delegates must respect the venues policy and abide by the guidance at all times.
