1. Projects generally must be within Devon or Cornwall (including the Isles of Scilly), however consideration will be given to projects delivered by teams from these counties within the wider South West region.
2. Building work must have been *(or to be completed) during 2020/21*
3. Closing date for entries is Friday, 26th November 2021
4. The fee for each nomination is £50+VAT and payable in advance
5. Judges will have the right to reject any entry for which the documentation does not comply with the competition rules.
6. The judges' decision is final. The discretion of the Judges to make or withhold an award is absolute. The Judges reserve the right to make no awards if suitably outstanding entries are not submitted.
7. Entries must be accompanied by completed entry form and photos/drawings as described below:
